

## **TVA Office of Inspector General Named As One of the 2017 Best Places to Work in the Federal Government**

The TVA Office of Inspector General (OIG) headquartered in Knoxville, Tennessee, has been named one of the Best Places to Work in the Federal Government in 2017. The award was given in a ceremony in Washington, D.C., Friday (January 26) by the non-profit Partnership for Public Service and Deloitte which does the ranking. The ranking is based upon the annual Federal Employee Viewpoint Survey conducted of federal government employees by the Office of Personnel Management. TVA OIG was ranked second among federal agency subcomponents. In 2017, there were 339 federal agency subcomponents included in the rankings. This marks TVA OIG's third consecutive year of being recognized as one of the best places to work in the federal government.
